

## Majority of the Cup/Rov Kos

The se<sup>der</sup> is the only time in the year that you must drink most of your cup (rov kos) of kiddush wine. (For kiddush on Shabbat and Jewish festivals, you need drink only 2 fl. oz., or 59 ml). So if you have a cup larger than 4 fl. oz. (119 ml), you may have to drink a lot of wine--more than half of each cup for four cups!

**NOTE** You may drink other liquids between the first and second cups of wine at the se<sup>der</sup>, but it is not recommended.
